

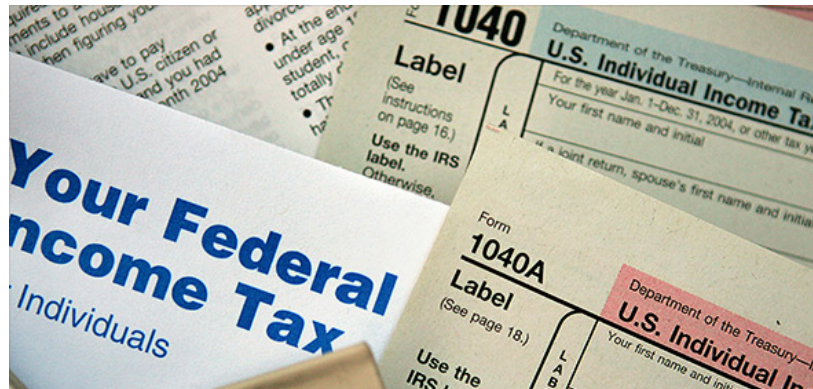
It's Tax Time . . . VITA is Coming to OLBR! What Is VITA?

VITA is “Volunteer Income Tax Assistance”

VITA is FREE Tax Help for those with annual incomes under \$54,000

VITA is coming here Wednesday, March 8th from 3:30 – 7:30 p.m.
(VITA will stop accepting clients at 6:30 p.m.)

VITA is University at Buffalo students from Beta Alpha Psi (Accounting & Finance)



VITA is here to help! Here's what you need to do and what you will bring to VITA:

- For married filing jointly, both spouses must be present.
- All Forms W-2 and 1099
- Information about any other income
- Information for all deductions/credits
- A copy of last year's tax return
- Proof of bank account for direct deposit of refund (check or bank account number/routing number)
- Social Security cards for you **AND** your dependents
- Proof of identification for you (and your spouse)...State license or passport
- Total paid to daycare provider and their tax ID number
- Birth dates for you, spouse, and or dependents on the return
- Proof of foreign status if applying for ITN
- Forms 1095-A, B or C (Affordable Health Care Statements)
