Re-Opening Plan for OLBR School:

Our 2020-21 OLBR Reopening plan is available to read on our website: olbrschool.org

This is a fluid document that will be maintained to include the most up to date information.

NYS is requiring all schools to submit building re-opening plans for September. Plans must include:

1. An in-school instruction model where students physically come to school (face-to-face with teacher following all social distancing guidelines);
2. A hybrid instruction model where students will physically be in school some days each week and will be required to work remotely from home on the other days each week.
3. A full remote instruction model, where students will be working from home (100% of instruction) on laptops (working face-to-face) with their teachers every day.

We have a dedicated team working very hard on OLBR's Re-Opening plan. Our number one concern is insuring safety and wellness for everyone during the COVID19 pandemic.

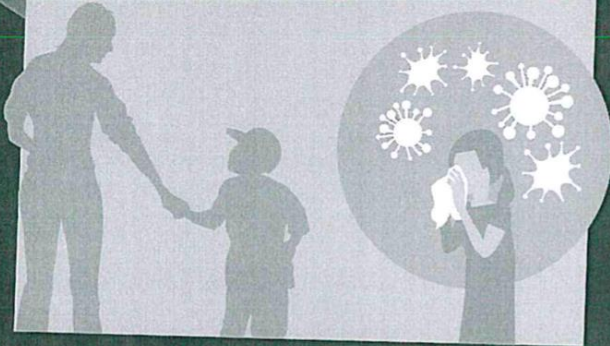

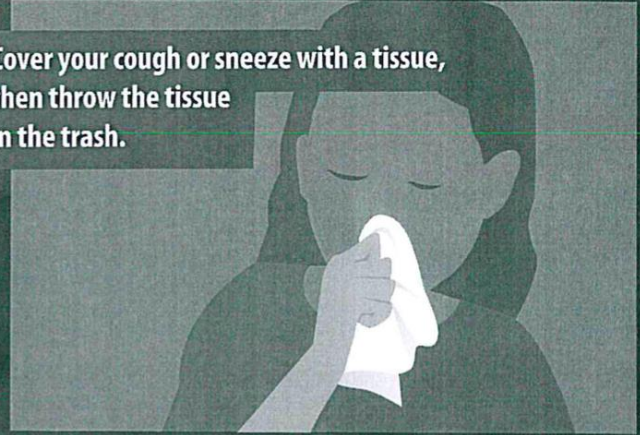
STOP THE SPREAD OF GERMS

Help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19.

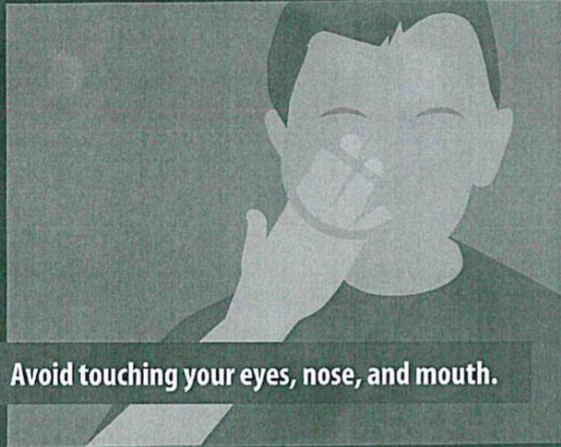
Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
